The ChiStar model CX 660 is an LCD projector with XGA 1024 x 768 resolution and a contrast of 500:1. The lamp life is up to 4000 hours, which is equivalent to over 5.5 years at 2 hours per day. 427 cm image width, the projector will be able to illuminate well. However, if room light is available, the picture width should ideally not exceed 285 cm. It is no longer offered by the manufacturer ChiStar.

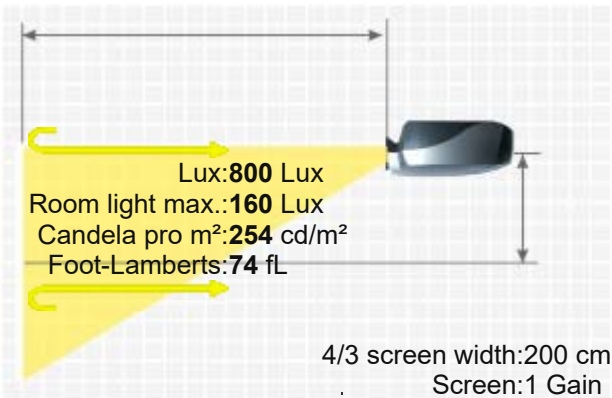
