Thanks to the horizontal and vertical keystone correction, the projector can be positioned very freely. 2000 Ansi lumens ensure that a picture width of 389 cm is also possible. However, if room light is available, the picture should be max. 259 cm wide. On the market since 2003, the model is no longer offered by the manufacturer Elmo.

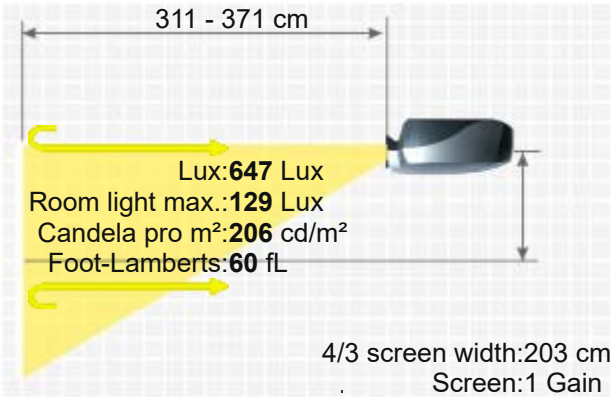
